Position Summary:

The Gaming Commission is an arm of the Tribal Government. Established in 2000 for exclusive purpose of Regulating and Monitoring Gaming for the La Jolla Band of Luiseno Indians and have been given the power and authority in the La Jolla Gaming Ordinance 003. This is to ensure compliance with Tribal, Federal, State Laws and Regulations.

The La Jolla Gaming Commission serves as the Licensing Authority for individuals and vendors of the gaming operation. Administering an effective program for the background investigations as part of the licensing process. The La Jolla Gaming Commission also has the role of monitoring compliance with the Internal Control Standards of the operation in tracking Tribal Revenues. The La Jolla Gaming Commission is responsible for the Surveillance of all gaming operations, for the "Protection of Tribal Assets", and their employees as well as the patrons of the gaming operation.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

Background Investigations

Issue, suspend, revoke, and renewal of gaming license for employees and vendors

Enforce Tribal Gaming Ordinance, Regulations, State and Federal Laws

Interact with other Tribal Gaming Commissions/Tribal Regulator's & Law Enforcement agencies

Qualifications:

To serve as a Commissioner, an individual must be at least twenty-five (25).

Must have a High Schools Diploma or GED



**Must be able to pass a back-ground investigation for a gaming license and maintain it.
No member of the Tribal Council and no employee of any gaming operation may serve
concurrently as a Gaming Commissioner.**

**Qualifications for Gaming Commissioner
La Jolla Gaming Regulation 003 (C) (1-4(a,b,c,d))**

- 1) To serve as a Commissioner, an individual must be at least twenty-five (25) years of age, be a U.S. citizen, and have experience in one or more of the following fields: accounting, law, law enforcement, gaming management or gaming regulation.
- 2) No member of the Tribal Council and no employee of any gaming operation may serve concurrently as a Commissioner.
- 3) No more than one member of the same immediate family may serve on the Commission at the same time. "Immediate family" means persons who are related as a father; mother, brother, sister, son, daughter, husband or wife.
- 4) The Tribal Council shall conduct or cause to be conducted a background investigation on each Commissioner either before or within thirty (30) days of the Commissioner's appointment. Should the background investigation result in any one of the following findings against the Commissioner or prospective Commissioner, he or she shall be disqualified from serving as a Commissioner:
 - (a) The person has been convicted, or is currently being prosecuted for, a felony or a crime of moral turpitude, including, but not limited to, fraud, theft, embezzlement, or a misdemeanor gaming offense;
 - (b) The person has knowingly or willingly provided materially false or misleading information to the Tribal Council or Tribe;
 - (c) The person has refused to respond to questions asked by Tribal Council that are relevant to the background investigation;
 - (d) A majority of the Tribal Council determines that the person is a person whose prior activities, criminal record, if any, or reputation, habits, and associations pose a threat to the public interest or to the effective regulation and control of gaming, or create or enhance the dangers of unsuitable, unfair or illegal practices, methods, and activities in the conduct of gaming or the carrying on of related business and financial arrangements.
